The Seafood & Sounds festival will be launched with a colourful parade at 11am on Saturday 13th September departing from the Slug & Lettuce (Poole's Old Town). Led by the fun and fab children's entertainer Jamie Jigsaw.

Followed by the Mayor Of Poole, carnival band Samba Panashe, mermaids from Forest Holme & volunteers from RNLI, children and parents from St James' Church, local Scouts, the brilliant Pirates of Poole plus Be Enchanted. It is going to be spectacular!

Everyone is encouraged to join in with the seafood theme of fancy-dress fun and/ or make fishes on sticks & masks. There will be prizes for the best outfits (under 7s, over 7s plus adults) along with the best decorated fish on a stick and the best seafood themed mask. The parade is kindly sponsored by Oriel Restaurant. Join the characters from Be Enchanted for a meet & greet on The Quay following the parade.

You can also take part in the popular biscuit decorating activity at the front of the hotel. More free family activities at St James' Church, head there for creative crafts and they will be serving refreshments all day. Outside there will be music and storytelling (see programme for times).


